We are Koreguaje, Muruy, Tanimuca, Saamaka, Yukuna, Huitoto, Monkoxi and Guarayos.





Our elders and ancestors have protected more than 10 million hectares of forest.

Now, it is our moment to protect it because **our home is threatened by extractivism, corruption, deforestation, and wildfires.**

The youth that today gathers feel the urgency to take an active part





in protecting the Amazon because, in that way, we are protecting our lives and our mother nature, and we honor the fight of our ancestors.

Since 2022, we are walking a path together. We are weaving a basket of experiences, knowledge, strengths, needs, concerns, and solutions.





We have called that process of weaving: **Tejiendo Katumare.**
