We invite you to join us for our annual Field Day which promises to be a fun filled day with two tours and a snack lunch, all located in and just outside Saskatoon SK.

Our day begins with:

9:00-11:30 - A Tour of the U of S Horticulture Research Farm which is located at 2909 – 14th Street, Saskatoon, SK



The focus will be on cherries, strawberries and raspberries. With sour cherries you can see our new and older varieties plus we have a project to evaluate black knot on chokecherries. We have ADOPT funded projects where strawberries and raspberries are grown in traditional ways plus with low or high tunnels. These last two projects are also testing newer varieties that have not been tried much in Saskatchewan.

12:30-1:30 - A Snack Lunch at Crossmount Cider Company located 5km south of Saskatoon on Lorne Avenue.

(The snack lunch is included with registration fee and will consist of a Hog Dog, shared Ploughman's Board with deli meat, cheese, crackers, and shared Queso Dip with Pita Chips & Dip)

2:00-3:00 - A Tour & Taste at Crossmount Cider Company

The Crossmount Orchard tour is about what makes the Crossmount orchard and prairie apples unique! You will also get some insight into the History of Crossmount and the Cidermaking process. The experience takes about 30-45 minutes, and you finish in the tasting room where you get to sample a cider tasting of 5 different flavours.
