“Fulminant Demyelinating Diseases of the Central Nervous System”

ABSTRACT:

Central nervous system demyelinating diseases occur in children and adults. Acute disseminated encephalomyelitis is a recognized form of fulminant demyelinating disease, but little information is available on outcomes and its conversion to relapsing disease. We will focus on a large multi-center cohort study of patients initially diagnosed as ADEM and their long-term outcomes as well as discuss a pending clinical trial for the use of a B-cell therapy for the treatment of fulminant demyelinating disease of the CNS in adults.

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
